Period:	28 months. Starting from January 1, 2022 , ending on April 30, 2024.

Designing, planning and executing studies, 2. coordination of the research, 3. analyzing of the collected data, 4. drafting and improving manuscripts, 5. presenting and discussing findings at conferences, seminars, and during working-meetings, 6. proper data management and research documentation, 7. guiding collaborating teams, 8. assembling and organizing data delivered by collaborating teams, and 9. other responsibilities typical for PhD students and research positions.
Financial conditions:	3,500 PLN – 5,000 PLN brutto brutto, i.e., including costs of employer (net salary will depend on the labor market regulations [e.g., "Polski Ład"]),
