Data management and research documentation, 2. communication with collaborating teams, 3. assembling and organizing data delivered by collaborating teams, 4. support in designing, planning, and executing studies, 5. support in analyzing collected data, 6. support in drafting and improving manuscripts. <p>Detailed scope of responsibilities to be agreed with each candidate based on her/his research interests and the need of lab members.</p>
Financial conditions:	<p>Basic stipend:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • for the first 1-2 months (probationary period) candidates may have no scholarship offered; • upon successful completion of probationary period, the basic stipend starts at 1000 zł.; <p>In exceptional cases, the stipend may be higher, or paid from the same beginning of collaboration.</p>
Additional provisions:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Selected students may be offered a budget for an active participation in international conference(s) and local seminars. 2. Selected students may be offered a budget for research.
Time involvement:	At least 10 hours/week (details to be agreed with each candidate).
Location:	Most of tasks can be carried out on-line/remotely. Students should be ready to participate in seminars twice a month in the Institute of Psychology of the Polish Academy of Sciences (Jaracza 1, Warsaw), but if a Candidate lives out of Warsaw, online participation in seminars will be understood.

Selection process:	<p>Candidates may be contacted by lab members (not only lab leader). Selected candidates will be:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. asked to perform "homework" tasks (to let us estimate Candidate's fit), and if their performance in doing "homework" will be evaluated as satisfactory, candidates may be 2. invited to an on-line interview. <p>Level of experience of candidates – Ma vs Ba vs PhD - will be taken into account.</p>
